Hermiston's Goodrich wins Thunder Mountain all-around title

Hermiston, Ore., cowboy Brad Goodrich filled his saddle bags with more than \$1,700 in prize money as the top all-around cowboy following the final performance of the 33rd annual Thunder Mountain Pro Rodeo at the Cowlitz County Exposition Center arena on Saturday night.

Goodrich picked up \$1,370.61 for having the top time in the tie-down roping in 8.9 seconds, and made \$361.24 for placing fifth in the steer wrestling in 5.8 seconds.

Roger Nonella of Klamath Falls finished second in the tie-down roping in 9.3 seconds for \$1,134.30, and Chehalis cowboy Joe Hoffman and Chase Taylor of Pendleton tied for third with identical times of 9.7 seconds, good for \$779.83 apiece.

Nik Hamm of Moses Lake claimed \$1,163.99 for winning the steer wrestling in 4.7 seconds. Tyler Woodland of Ontario, Ore., and Travis Carnine of Stanfield, Ore., turned in identical times of 4.9 seconds to tie for second place, worth \$862.95 apiece.

Wenatchee's Garrett Wolfe was the lone bull rider among 13 contestants to stay aboard for the required time and 65 points, earning him \$1,076.67.

Kayle Gray of Cheney, Wash., won the top prize money for the lone second-go score

in the saddle bronc riding with 73, and claimed the top two-ride score of 135, good for \$431.93. Ben Londo of Pendleton won the first-go with 78 points for \$431.93, with Derk Robinson of Clarkston, Wash., in second with 74 for \$323.95.

Londo was second for the top two-ride money with 78 despite staying aboard in the his second ride, earning \$323.95.

Washougal's Jason Sherman had the top two-ride score in the bareback riding with 160 for \$440.80, which included winning the second-go with 82 points for \$440.80, and tying for first in the first-go with 78 for \$385.70. Londo had the second-best two-ride score with 155 for \$330.60, which included tying for second in the second-go with 79 for \$275.50, and third in the first-go with 76 for \$220.40.

B.J. Campbell of Benton City, Wash., and Russell Cardoza of Farmington, Calif., rode off with \$1,267.30 apiece for winning the team roping in 5.7 seconds. Wade Wheatley of Hughson, Calif., and Justin Davis of Cottonwood, Calif., placed second in 5.9 seconds, good for \$1,048.80 apiece.

Brenda Mays of Terrebonne, Ore., the world's sixth-ranked barrel racer, added the Thunder Mountain Pro Rodeo title to her credit with a victory in 17.17 seconds, good for \$848.87. Kelli Currin of Dayton, Wash., was close behind in second with 17.23 for \$727.60, and Barbra West of Oak Harbor and Linzie Walker of Conway, Wash., tied for third with identical times of 17.37, good for \$565.91 apiece.
