**PARKING AND ENTRY RULES FOR VISITING ROYLATY**

To ensure adequate horse trailer parking is available for contestants, volunteers, and participants, only trucks with trailers will be allowed in contestant parking. Visiting Royalty with additional vehicles not towing a horse trailer will not be allowed to park in contestant parking and will need to park in the general parking area for the Cowlitz County Fair on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. There is a \$5 general parking fee. To enter the contestant areas, you will need to **wear your wrist band at all times**. Wrist bands will be given free of charge to each queen/princess and one companion/advisor wrist band per young lady. Your visiting royalty wrist band will also allow you access to the contestant seating area. Any additional guests above the allowed amount will need to purchase a general admission ticket at the corresponding evening's price.

\*Note: a general admission ticket will not allow you access to contestant parking.

**Driving directions to the Arena:**

**From I- 5 N. or S. Take exit 36 follow onto Tennant Way.**

**Take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit at the end of the off ramp turn right.**

**Follow 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave it will turn into 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. at the 2<sup>nd</sup> light turn left. (by the Court house) onto Washington St.**

**Go 1 block to 3rd Ave. turn left you will be by the coroner's office. Go about 100 yards arena entrance is on the right, sheriffs will be at the gate with a list.**
